WHAT, is the United Mutual Doing?

On Monday, November 15, 2010, The United Laguna Hills Mutual Board of Directors passed a motion entitled, ***“Open Session Board Meeting Attendance and Member Forum Rules.”*** The following paragraph is an excerpt from the motion that was passed with no amendments to it;

“In accordance with California Civil Code 1363.05 (h), the Board shall hold a Member Forum (each such forum, a “Forum”) before or after any meeting of the Members, or before or after any open session meeting of the Board. During a Forum, the Board shall permit Members of United to address the Board on any matters(s) relating to the business and affairs of United, (including items on the agenda).”

The underlined portion is a paraphrase of what was added at the closed session preceding this open Board meeting. Interpreting this paragraph, which was reviewed and OK’d by the United attorney, Sandra Gottlieb, and passed without amendments, the United Members have effectively passed a motion that;

1. Pertains to any United Mutual meeting of the Members, or open session meeting of the Board, and which,

2. Shall hold a Member forum (historically called Members Comments), either,
3. Before or after the Member or Board meeting, where they can address the Board on any matter (s) relating to the business affairs of United.

What have they accomplished? Complete restriction of any input from the Members during a Board meeting. Considering that this was reviewed by our corporate attorney, with her input, why should we be charged an attorney fee that does the following;
